Dear Camp Worker,

Before you know it, it will be Camp time again. -- The birds chirping, the sounds of the kitchen help up and at it early making fresh coffee for all the workers and the sleepy sounds of campers dragging their stuff for an early morning shower, kickball and skinned knees....memory verses and campfire skits....All part of the Mountain Top experience.

This year the Gospel of John will be our focus for spiritual study. (Jesus as the Son of God) Our verse above should echo the reason we all want to work at the Camp –to introduce boys and girls to the Lamb of God as John did. We have a saying in our household – “It’s not all about you”! That is exactly what John was doing –deflecting his followers to follow Jesus. At camp you and I are only deflectors and reflectors. We deflect the praise to God and we reflect the ways of Jesus to the campers. We are excited about year #22 of MTBC. How about you?

Camp this year will be June 9-14, 2018 for the campers. The campers will arrive Saturday, June 9th and leave on Thursday, June 14th. The staff will arrive on Thursday, June 7th @3:00 pm to move in, get set up and ready. Food will arrive on Friday morning, June 8th. This will give us 1 ½ days to get things set up and ready before the campers arrive on Saturday. Campers will leave Thursday evening, June 14th. Staff departure will be Friday, June 15th by 11:00 am. In addition to full and part-time help during the week, we will need additional help moving in and moving out. Maybe you would like to help but can’t be there all week, consider the ministry of setting up and tearing down. It would be a great help, especially on departure day because those who have been there all week will be close to exhaustion! This basically requires loading and unloading supplies, and delivering them to their respective places before camp begins and after campers leave. There is something for everyone to do!! BUT REMEMBER.....if you have signed up for

a time slot to help we will expect you to be there to fulfill your obligation. Thank you for understanding this.

Attached you will find an application, which is pretty self-explanatory. If you have any questions, please feel free to call us anytime (814)977-6615 (Brenda) or (814)977-1925 (Joe). Please have your applications returned to us by April 15th, 2018. Please fill one out for whatever capacity you would desire to be involved with. This helps our planning for many aspects-especially meals. ****NOTE-The medical page does not need to be returned by 4/15/18, but must be turned in by camp registration (day you arrive).**

We desire your prayers in three ways. 1) For God, through the Holy Spirit, to direct us in every way for the planning and preparation. 2) For God, through the Holy Spirit, to speak to you on how and when you can serve. 3) For God, through the Holy Spirit, to reach the children He wants to be at camp. Remember, the camp can hold 70-80 children so let's pray and recruit so the camp will be full!! Ages for campers include those who have finished 2nd grade through those who have finished 8th grade.

P.S. If you desire to be a teacher this year, our theme will be from any portion in John. Look it over and let us know what you desire to teach so there is no duplication. If you would rather we choose something for you, feel free to ask. (You will only need to prepare ONE lesson that will be targeted to a different group of campers each day, adjusting it to the different ages.)
